

Request to Remove Personal Information from the Smith County Appraisal District Website

According to the Public Information Act, the public has a right to access and/or copy your property tax information including your name. Since the Act does not require a governmental body to provide public access to the Internet, the Smith County Appraisal District may remove your name from the information posted on its website at www.smithcad.org and www.smithcountymapsite.org upon your written request. After you submit this completed form to the Smith County Appraisal District, your name will be replaced with "CURRENT OWNER" as the account owner posted on those websites. This service is subject to change according to changes in state or federal law.

NOTICE : YOUR NAME WILL ONLY BE REMOVED FROM THE INFORMATION POSTED ON THE SMITH COUNTY APPRAISAL DISTRICT WEBSITE AT WWW.SMITHCAD.ORG AND WWW.SMITHCOUNTYMAPSITE.ORG AND WILL NOT BE REMOVED FROM INFORMATION OTHERWISE PROVIDED TO THE PUBLIC, INCLUDING INFORMATION PROVIDED IN ELECTRONIC FORM PURSUANT TO THE PUBLIC INFORMATION ACT.
